Camp Kirk is a small overnight camp for children who have Learning Disabilities, AD/HD, and High Functioning Autism. We strive to build resilience and self-esteem in our campers by providing a supportive, nurturing, and non-competitive environment.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Eco Instructor is responsible for planning and facilitating programming that engages campers with the natural world. Whether this is through free exploration of our Bucky Mucky Swamp or a guided whole-group activity, we hope to inspire a nature connection in our campers and we hope to do so in a fun and engaging manner.

The Eco Instructor is part of the program staff team. In addition to their program areas, all program staff are involved with the planning and facilitation of all-camp activities in the evening. When available, program staff are assigned to provide extra support to either individual campers or cabin groups who require it.

CONTRACT DETAILS

The dates of employment run from June 18th to August 28th. All staff members reside at camp and Room & Board is provided free of charge. The summer salary for a first year staff is \$3000.
