Responsibilities

The Leadership Director is a member of Camp Kirk's summer management team. Alongside the Camp Directors and Program Director, this individual will help ensure the smooth operation of the camp, and the wellbeing of the campers and staff.

The Leadership Director plans and facilitates Camp Kirk's leadership programming for Leaders-in-Training and Counsellors-in-Training (i.e. the LIT/CIT Program) and teen campers (i.e. Teen Programs). Specific duties include:

LIT/CIT Program

- Directly supervise 6-8 LIT/CIT participants (ages 16-18)
- Plan and facilitate team building and leadership programming for the LIT/CIT group.
- Train and supervise the staff to work with and support their assigned LIT/CIT's.

Teen Program

- Design and coordinate a leadership program for 2-3 cabin groups of participants in the Teen Program (ages 14-16).
- Supervise and support the Teen Program counsellors to implement programming.

Qualifications and Experience

- G-level Ontario driver's license, or equivalent
- 3+ years work experience in a summer camp setting. Direct experience working with children who have special needs is necessary.
