ORGANIZATION

Camp Kirk is a small overnight camp for children who have Learning Disabilities, AD/HD, and High Functioning Autism. We strive to build resilience and self-esteem in our campers by providing a supportive, nurturing, and non-competitive environment.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Martial Arts Instructor is responsible for planning and facilitating a recreational martial arts program that is fun and engaging for groups of campers aged 6-14. Decisions regarding the structure of the program and the style of martial arts will be the responsibility of the individual in charge. It is important to note, the Martial Arts program at Camp Kirk is a means of raising the self-esteem of our campers, and therefore all programming is completely non-competitive.

The Martial Arts Instructor is part of the program staff team. In addition to their program areas, all program staff are involved with the planning and facilitation of all-camp activities in the evening. When available, program staff are assigned to provide extra support to either individual campers or cabin groups who require it.

CONTRACT DETAILS

The dates of employment run from June 18th to August 28th. All staff members reside at camp and Room & Board is provided free of charge. The summer salary for a first year staff is \$3000.

REQUIREMENTS

- 19 years of age by June 19th
- Previous experience teaching or leading a martial arts program
- Strong facilitation skills and previous experience leading group activities
- Previous experience working with children is necessary
- Previous experience working with children with exceptionalities is an asset
- CPR and Standard First Aid certification
