ORGANIZATION

Camp Kirk is a registered charity that provides residential programming for children who have learning disabilities, attention deficit disorders, and high functioning autism. We offer a nurturing and non-competitive environment that emphasizes strengths and builds confidence. We provide a community experience that promotes strong mental health so that our campers can lead productive, meaningful and happy lives.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Pottery Instructor is responsible for all aspects of the pottery program. This includes planning and facilitating programming on a daily basis, firing pottery with the use of the kiln as required by the camp session timeline, and the ordering of clay & supplies.

In addition to their program areas, all program staff are involved with the planning and facilitation of all-camp activities in the evening. As well, when available, program staff are assigned to provide extra support to either individual campers or cabin groups who require it or around camp as necessary.

CONTRACT DETAILS

The dates of employment run from **June 18th until August 27th**. All staff members reside at camp and Room and Board is provided over and above the salary. The summer salary for first-year staff is \$3240.

REQUIREMENTS

- 19 years of age by June 18th
- Previous experience with a kiln is an asset, but not mandatory. Training will be provided
- Knowledge and experience creating both hand-made and wheel-made pottery
- Previous experience working with children
- Previous experience working with individuals with exceptionalities is an asset
- CPR and Standard First Aid certification
- A current Criminal Record Check
