ORGANIZATION

Camp Kirk is a small overnight camp for children who have Learning Disabilities, AD/HD, and High Functioning Autism. We strive to build resilience and self-esteem in our campers by providing a supportive, nurturing, and non-competitive environment.

JOB DESCRIPTION

The Ropes Course and Leadership Instructor will be responsible for planning and facilitating a program that utilizes our high- and low ropes course elements and our rock climbing walls. The aim of our Ropes & Leadership program is to develop leadership skills, group dynamics, and personal challenge through a non-competitive and nurturing approach.

As part of the Program Staff, the Ropes Instructor would also be a part of the team that plans and facilitates all-camp program in the evenings. When available, program staff also provide additional support to individual campers or cabin groups who require it.

CONTRACT DETAILS

The dates of employment run from June 18th to August 28th. All staff members reside at camp and Room & Board is provided free of charge. The summer salary for a first year staff is \$3000.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 19 years old by June 19th
- Previous experience facilitating rock climbing or ropes course programming (NOTE: Camp Kirk will pay for the successful applicant to gain formal certification and training)
- Previous experience working with children
- Previous experience working with individuals with exceptionalities is an asset
- First Aid/CPR certification
- A current Criminal Record Check
