



Job Posting: Laundry + Camp Nanny

ORGANIZATION

Camp Kirk is a registered charity that provides recreational programming for children who have learning disabilities, attention deficit disorders, and/or autism. We offer a nurturing and non-competitive environment that emphasizes strengths and builds confidence. We provide a community experience that promotes strong mental health so that our campers can lead productive, meaningful and happy lives.

JOB DESCRIPTION + DUTIES

The Laundry + Nanny staff is a member of Camp Kirk's summer staff team. The hired individual will be responsible for:

Nanny Duties (80%)

- One-on-one childcare for the Camp Director's 2-year-old child. Care includes feeding, bathing, and providing stimulating opportunities to learn and play.
- Light housekeeping and cooking duties for the Camp Director's cabin

Laundry Duties (20%)

- Washing, drying and folding all camp laundry. This includes laundry from camper cabins, canoe trips, the kitchen and the Health Hub.
- Maintaining the laundry room in a clean and organized state
- If needed, providing support for general chores around camp

CONTRACT DETAILS + COMPENSATION

The dates of employment run from **June 14th - September 2nd**. Staff reside at camp in cabins with 2-4 other staff members. Room and Board is provided over and above the salary.

The compensation for first-year staff is \$3,335*

**\$2,635 base salary + \$700 bonus compensation for submitting contract documents on time and completing the summer season*

REQUIREMENTS & EXPECTATIONS

- 19 years of age by June 2021
- Able to obtain CPR and Standard First Aid certification by June 2021
- Previous experience working with toddlers is required
