



Job Posting: Camp Nanny

ORGANIZATION

Camp Kirk empowers neurodiverse kids and youth to reach their potential through recreational programs. Within a small and nurturing community, our programs emphasise strengths so that participants can develop confidence, connection and Community.

DUTIES + RESPONSIBILITIES

The Camp Nanny is a member of Camp Kirk's summer staff team. They will be responsible for providing childcare for the Executive Director's family. The Director's husband will be on paternity leave and will be working with the camp nanny to take care of their two kids (age 3.5 year and 14 weeks)- the camp nanny can expect to take care of one child at any given time.

Nanny duties include:

- Providing supervision and care. The 3-year-old and the nanny will be able to roam camp and join in at programming at times. However, they may also be on their own exploring the surrounding area (i.e. ice cream runs, visiting Balsam Lake...).
- Light food prep and helping with hygiene tasks (bathing, diaper changes)
- General support for the family (i.e. help with chores, tidying cabin)
- When available, the camp nanny may be asked to provide support for the general camp program (i.e. helping with cabin groups or activities)

NOTE: Both live-in and live-out arrangements are possible- we are happy to discuss either option. If living on-site, the camp nanny will be living in a staff cabin with 3-4 other staff members.

CONTRACT DETAILS + COMPENSATION

The dates of employment run from June 14th - August 30th, 2022 (dates negotiable)

Compensation: \$650/week + room and board

REQUIREMENTS + EXPECTATIONS

- All staff are required to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19
- Previous childcare experience is necessary
