#### POSITION OVERVIEW

The Counselling Director is a member of Camp Kirk's summer Administration Team. Working collaboratively, the 'Admin Team' ensures the smooth operation of the camp, and the wellbeing of the campers and staff.

The Counselling Director is responsible for overseeing camper care and wellbeing. Through mentorship of the Counselling Staff, the Counselling Director ensures campers and cabins have the necessary support for a successful camp experience. Specific duties include:

- Act as the director supervisor for Counsellor Staff (15-17 staff members)
- Collaborate with the Camp Director and Assistant Director to create support plans for campers and cabin groups
- Create daily coverage schedules for the staff team
- Assist in the management of daily camp operations
- Act as a member of the Crisis Response Team
